CHIEF COMPLAINT: Persistent chest pain and shortness of breath for the past two weeks.

HISTORY OF PRESENT ILLNESS: Mr. Bertrand is a 52-year-old male with a history of hypertension and hyperlipidemia who presents with intermittent chest pain that started two weeks ago. He describes the pain as a pressure-like sensation located in the central chest, radiating to his left shoulder. The pain typically occurs with exertion and is relieved with rest. He also reports episodes of shortness of breath and mild dizziness. No history of nausea, vomiting, diaphoresis, or palpitations. No recent illness or fever. He denies any previous episodes of similar pain. He has been compliant with his medications, including lisinopril and atorvastatin, but admits to occasional missed doses. His lifestyle includes a sedentary job, minimal exercise, and a diet high in processed foods. He has a 20-pack-year smoking history but quit five years ago. He drinks alcohol occasionally and denies illicit drug use.

REVIEW OF SYSTEMS: General: No fever, chills, or weight loss. Cardiovascular: Reports exertional chest pain and shortness of breath. No palpitations or syncope. Respiratory: No cough, wheezing, or hemoptysis. Gastrointestinal: No nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain, or melena. Neurological: No headaches, vision changes, or focal neurological deficits. Musculoskeletal: No joint pain or swelling. Psychiatric: No significant anxiety or depression symptoms.
