## **eScripture One InCommand SSO Maintenance for Clinicians Release Notes**

## What's New?

DeliverHealth is pleased to announce the release of an InCommand Client Maintenance update, allowing Single Sign-On (SSO) invitations to be sent and revoked for individual clinician user profiles, as well as unenroll profiles from SSO. This functionality is useful when a new user profile is added or if SSO is no longer needed.

### SSO Invitation

Provided the client has a valid tenant, InCommand users with the proper access can invite additional clinicians or staff to use Single Sign-on (SSO) to log into InQuery, eSone mobile apps, and InSync. Contact the support team for assistance with the initial SSO setup.

To invite a user, navigate to Client Maintenance > Users, select the profile from the Users list and click **Edit <user username>**. Expand the Password and Security Options section. Click the **invite user to SSO** button to send an invitation to email address of the user profile.

**Note:** Invitations are valid for 3 days and will need to be resent if user has not accepted.

## Revoke SSO Invitation

If an SSO invitation has been sent, but not accepted, the invitation can be revoked. Click the **revoke SSO invite** button in the user profile. If the user later accepts the invite from the email, SSO enrollment no longer be valid.

If an invitation needs to be resent, the **revoke SSO invite** button will change to **invite user to use SSO**, allowing a new invitation to be sent.

## Unenroll From SSO

If SSO is no longer needed, click **unenroll user from SSO**. This will revert the profile to the traditional log in process using username, password, and client. The user can be invited again by following the invitation process.
